

Application fee for bespoke permits

You have to submit an application fee when applying for a bespoke environmental permit. The fee depends on the type of bespoke permit you are applying for. Select the application type permit that you wish to apply for to find out the application fee.

1. **Fee for waste operations and installations and mining waste**
2. **Fee for standard alone point source water discharges**
3. **Fee for groundwater activities, for example spreading onto land**

The application fees are valid until the 31st March 2012. If you are submitting an application after this date please contact us on 08708 506 506*.

1. Fee for waste operations and installations and mining waste

The fee for waste activities, installations and mining waste depends on a number of different factors. To find out what fee you need to submit with your application please see our [charging guidance](#).

To submit an application form for a waste operation, installation or mining waste you will need to complete Part A, F1, B2 and then B3, 4 or 5 depending which activity you are applying for. Please see our [application forms](#) for further information.

2. Fee for standard alone point source water discharges

Standard Application 2011/2012 - £ 885.00

Reduced Application Charge 2011/2012 - £125.00

The reduced application charge applies where the effluent is any of the following:

- domestic sewage effluent of 5m³ a day or less
- a sewage effluent from a trade premises (e.g. a hotel) of 5m³ a day or less
- cooling water of 10m³ or less
- surface water
- site drainage

To submit an application form for a small scale sewage effluent of 5m³ a day or less you will only need to complete Part B6.5. Please see our [application forms](#) for further information.

To submit an application form for any other standalone point source water discharge you will need to complete Part A, F2, B2 and then B6. Please see our [application forms](#) for further information.

3. Fee for standalone groundwater discharge for (example spreading activities)

Category	Substance volume	Application fee
Small liquid discharges	Sheep dip less than or equal to 10 m ³ per year or Pesticide washings - All volumes	£390
Medium liquid discharges	Sheep dip greater than 10m ³ per year but less than or equal to 50 m ³ per year (Not applicable to pesticide washings.)	£600
Large liquid discharges	Sheep dip greater than 50m ³ per year (Not applicable to pesticide washings.)	£960
