

## Application charge to change (vary) a permit

You have to submit an application charge to change (vary) a permit. The application charge that you pay depends on the type of application you are submitting. Select the type of permit that you wish to vary to find out the application charge.

1. Charge for waste operations and installations and mining waste
2. Charge for standard alone point source water discharges
3. Charge for standalone groundwater discharges (for example spreading activities)

The application charges are valid until the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012. If you are submitting an application after this date please contact us on 08708 506 506\*.

### 1. Charge for waste operations, installations and mining waste

The application charge to change (vary) a permit for a waste activities, installations and mining waste depends on a number of different factors. To find out what application charge you need to submit with your application please see our [charging pages](#).

To submit an application form to vary a bespoke waste operation, installation or mining waste permit you will need to complete Part A, F1, C2 and then C3, C4 or C5 depending on the type of activity. Please see our [application forms](#) for further information.

To submit an application form to vary or change to a standard rules waste operation, installation or mining waste permit you will need to complete Part A, F1 and C1.

### 2. Charge for standard alone point source water discharges

**Standard Application** 2010/2011 - £885.00

**Reduced Application Charge** 2010/2011 - £125.00

The Reduced Application Charge applies where the effluent is any of the following:

- domestic sewage effluent of 5m<sup>3</sup> a day or less
- sewage effluent from a trade premises (e.g. Hotel) of 5m<sup>3</sup> a day or less
- cooling water of 10m<sup>3</sup> or less
- surface water
- site drainage

### 3. Charge for standalone groundwater discharges (for example spreading activities)

Category	Substance volume	Application fee
Small liquid discharges	Sheep dip less than or equal to 10 m <sup>3</sup> per year or Pesticide washings - All volumes	£75
Medium liquid discharges	Sheep dip greater than 10m <sup>3</sup> per year but less than or equal to 50 m <sup>3</sup> per year (Not applicable to pesticide washings.)	£370
Large liquid discharges	Sheep dip greater than 50m <sup>3</sup> per year (Not applicable to pesticide washings.)	£530
