If you carry other people's waste or your own construction waste you may now be an upper tier waste carrier. [Read our guidance on how the new two-tier registration system for carrying waste, and other changes in the Waste Regulations 2011, affect you.](#)

You need to check that anyone collecting or transporting your waste is registered correctly under the new two-tier registration system. [Make sure you know what evidence to ask your waste carrier for with our guidance on how the changes may affect you.](#)
