**EMERGENCY AND INCIDENT REPORTING IN THE DEE CONSERVANCY**

Mariners are hereby reminded of the requirement for the reporting of marine emergencies and incidents in the Dee Conservancy.

**EMERGENCY REPORTING**

Any marine emergency or incident that could endanger life or lead to a possible hazardous situation developing within the Dee Conservancy should be immediately reported to the Maritime Coastguard Agency (MCA) by:

**Tel 999 – ask for the Coastguard  
or  
VHF Channel 16**

**INCIDENT REPORTING**

In addition to the above and for all other incidents the office of Dee Conservancy Harbour Master can be contacted on:

**Tel 0151 632 3355 during office hours  
or  
Tel 0800 80 70 60 – ask for Wales RCC  
(Environment Agency 24 hour reporting line)**
