

2007 summer floods - Environment Agency - A table showing the number of properties that received flood warnings in the affected areas.

During the floods we issued nearly 500 warnings in over 350 flood warning areas, of which over 60 were severe flood warnings. Currently we believe approximately 80 flood warnings were issued that did not provide a 2 hour warning of river flooding
